

MOL LEAGUE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

The Disciplinary Committee no.2016-17/038 decree

The Disciplinary Committee investigated the MOL League game MOL 156 (Fehervari Titanok – UTE) where after 54 minutes Balazs VARGA (Fehervari Titanok) penalized 2 minutes (CHARG). The Committee made the following conclusions:

The player of the Fehervari Titanok collided with the opponent player in the 54th minute of the match. During the collision, he hit the head of the UTE player.

IIHF RULE 124 – CHECKING TO THE HEAD OR NECK

DEFINITION: A player who directs a hit of any sort, with any part of his body or equipment, to the head or neck of an opposing player or drives or forces the head of an opposing player into the protective glass or boards. This rule supersedes all similar actions regarding hits to the head and neck except those related to fighting.

There is no such thing as a clean hit to the head. Whether accidental or intentional, every direct hit to the head or neck of an opponent will be penalized. A player who injures or recklessly endangers an opponent as a result of checking to the head or neck will be assessed a match penalty.

According to the establishment of the Disciplinary Comitee, the player crashed into the opponent player's head with his elbow and hand, from a great distance without the intention of acquiring the puck. There is no regular impact to the head. The player of the Fehervari Titanok needlessly and recklessly endangered the physical safety of the fellow player by the collision.

The Disciplinary Committee prohibited Balazs VARGA, the Fehervari Titanok player to 3 MOL League match.

The player will spend down his sentence at the next MOL League or Hungarian Cup matches.
