

MOL LEAGUE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

The Disciplinary Committee no.2016-17/041 decree

The Disciplinary Committee investigated the MOL League game MOL 160 (Ferencvarosi TC – Sport Club Csikszereda) where Akos KISS player of Ferencvarosi TC was being penalized 20 minutes for unsportsmanlike behavior (GA-MI). The Disciplinary Committee made the following conclusion:

The player criticized the referee's action in a vulgar and unsportsmenlike tone, he swore and insulted the referee with an ethnic prejudice.

IIHF RULE 168 – UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT

DEFINITION: A player or team official who commits a violation of the rules pertaining to sportsmanship, fair play, and respect.

Misconduct Penalty - If a violation is flagrant or if a player continues his unsportsmanlike conduct, he may be assessed a misconduct penalty.

Match Penalty - A player or team official who threatens, makes racial or ethnic slurs, spits, smears blood, or makes sexual remarks to any person will be assessed a match penalty.

According to the establishment of the Disciplinary Comitee, the player behaved unsportsmenlikely against the referee. National, ethnic or racist insulting of any participants of the hockey musn't be part of the game.

The MOL League's Disciplinary Committee will continue to penalty the participants, who question the integrity of referees, insults, threatening arise against them, or make any physical contact with them, with the most stringent sanctions.

The Disciplinary Committee prohibited Akos KISS, the Ferencearosi TC player to 2 MOL League match.

The player will spend down his sentence at the next MOL League or Hungarian Cup matches.
