



MOL LEAGUE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

The Disciplinary Committee no.2016-17/086 decree

The Disciplinary Committee investigated the MOL League game MOL 258 (MAC Budapest – Debreceni HK) where Jesse SCHULTZ player of Debreceni HK was being penalized 25 minutes for unsportsmanlike conduct (UN-SP). The Committee made the following conclusions:

In the 60th minute of the match after the final whistle, the player pushed the referee and criticized his activities in unsportsmanlike tone. The case is not visible on the video. According to the referee's log, and the supervisor's report, the contact happened clearly deliberate.

IIHF RULE 168 – UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT

DEFINITION: A player or team official who commits a violation of the rules pertaining to sportsmanship, fair play, and respect.

IIHF RULE 116 – ABUSE OF OFFICIALS

DEFINITION: An attempt by a player or team official to usurp the power of an on-ice official, demean or degrade an on-ice official, call into question the integrity or ability of an on-ice official, or physically confront an on-ice official.

Match Penalty - A player or team official who makes contact in any way with an on-ice official and is detrimental to the conducting of a game.

The MOL League's Disciplinary Committee will continue to penalty the participants, who question the integrity of referees, insults, threatening arise against them, or make any physical contact with them, with the most stringent sanctions.

The Disciplinary Committee prohibited Jesse SCHULTZ, the Debreceni HK player for 2 matches.

Jesse SCHULTZ was imposed Match Penalty (MATCH) during the game.

IIHF RULE 110 – DURATION OF PENALTIES/MATCH

A match penalty carries with it an automatic (and minimum) one-game suspension.

Jesse SCHULTZ will skip plus 1 match of his team.

The player will spend down his sentence at the next MOL League matches.
