Time of Incident: 58:33, EL 149 game, Corona Brasov - FEHA19 playoff match 2

Players Involved: FEHA19 #9 Erdősi Csanád
Corona Brasov #12 Bors Huba-Ferenc

Call on the Ice: The infraction was not noticed by the officials and therefore no call was made during the game.

The Referee in Chief reported the incident for review.

Injury: There was no recorded injury.

IIHF Rule 62 SPEARING

Spearing shall mean stabbing an opponent with the point / toe of the stick blade, whether contact is made or not.

MAJOR PENALTY AND GAME MISCONDUCT PENALTY

The Referee, at their discretion, shall assess a major penalty and an automatic game misconduct penalty to a Player guilty who "spears" an opponent.

Review of Incident:

At 58:33 play was along the boards with players trying to gain possession of the puck. At this time FEHA19 #9 Erdősi Csanád came together with Bors Huba-Ferenc ending up bending forward towards the ice. At his time FEHA19 #9 Erdősi Csanád pushed Bors Huba-Ferenc head towards the ice. Bors Huba-Ferenc took exception to this and punched him when he stood upright. The players then separated as the puck was now in the possession of the BRA defenseman at the blueline. Bors Huba-Ferenc started skating towards the net. When Bors Huba-Ferenc approached Erdősi Csanád's left side he spun and swung his stick spearing him in the chest area.

The Committee Ruling:

- FEHA19 #9 Erdősi Csanád deliberately speared BRA #12 Bors Huba-Ferenc due to the punch from incident seconds before that should have been penalized.



- The puck was not in the vicinity so there was no legal way for Erdősi Csanád to check Bors Huba-Ferenc in any manner as it was not a positional fight or a fight for the puck.
- It was an intentional high-force slash / stab to the body that was a dangerous action which could have resulted in a serious injury

As a result, they categorized the foul as a clear, intentional foul. Therefore, it was classified as Deliberate Sudden Arousal Category 3 (2-5). They ruled the slash was retribution to the previous punch. Erdősi Csanád **will be suspended for two games for the infraction** and according to the Erste Liga Competition Rules 73. § (1) the sanction imposed an automatic fine on the FEHA19. The organization must pay a fine of EUR 400.

The player will spend down his suspension at the next Erste Liga games.
