**Time of Incident:** 50:06, EL 176, Gyergyói Hoki Klub - DVTK Jegesmedvék semi-final game 2

**Players Involved:** DVTK # 27 Johan Henrik Marklund  
GYHK #28 Daniel Tranca

**Call on the Ice:** DVTK #27 was assessed a minor penalty for tripping.

The Head of the Referee's Working Group requested an investigation for the play. The records have not shown an injury.

#### IIHF RULE 52 Slew Foot

1. "Slew-footing" is the act of a Player using their leg or foot to knock or kick an opponent's feet from under them or pushes an opponent's upper body backward with an arm or elbow, and at the same time with a forward motion of their leg, knocks or kicks the opponent's feet from under them, causing them to fall violently to the ice.
2. The Referee shall, at their discretion, assess a major penalty and an automatic game misconduct penalty if a Player is guilty of "slew-footing" on an opposing Player
3. If the action is minimal or the opponent is not violently thrown to the ice, the Referees may choose to use rules 51 Roughing or 57 Tripping to address this action.

#### IIHF RULE 61.6. DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

If deemed appropriate, Supplementary Discipline can be applied by the Proper Authorities at their discretion.

#### Review of Incident:

At 50:06 the puck is dumped into the GYHK defending end. DVTK #27 Johan Henrik Marklund and GYHK #28 Daniel Tranca engaged at the blueline. As they move into the zone, Marklund places his right leg behind Tranca and moves his leg forward making contact with his shin and the back of Tranca's leg causing him fall to the ice on his right side.

#### The Committee Ruling:

- As the puck is not near either player, so there is no legal check Marklund can make on Tranca other than both players battling for position.



- Tranca does see Marklund to his left and engages with him using his left arm.
- From the video it is difficult to see if Marklund pulls back with his upper body but does use leg from behind causing Tranca to fall backwards.
- The play meets the standard under the Slew-footing rule.
- However, under the rule there is leeway for the official to call the penalty tripping if the fall is not dangerous or violent.
- Although the play was ill advised; it was not considered violent.

As a result, the Committee categorized the incident as Careless (0-3) but there will be **no further disciplined assessed to Marklund for the play.**
