



Erste Liga Disciplinary Committee

no.2023-24/041 decree

The Disciplinary Committee investigated the Erste Liga game EL 177 (FTC-Telekom - Sport Club Csíkszereda) where in the 20th minute Kubat Karel (Sport Club Csíkszereda) penalized 2+10+20 minutes for unsportsmanlike conduct.

IIHF RULE 75 UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT

Players, Coaches and team personnel are responsible for their conduct at all times and must endeavor to prevent disorderly conduct before, during or after the game, on or off the ice and any place in the Rink. The Referees may assess penalties to any of the above Team Personnel for failure to do so. When such conduct is directed at an official → Rule 39 – Abuse of Officials shall be applied.

IIHF RULE 39 ABUSE OF OFFICIALS

A Player, Coach or team personnel shall not challenge or dispute the rulings of an Official before, during or after a game, on or off the ice and any location while in the arena and its connected premises. A Player, Coach or team personnel shall not display “Unsportsmanlike Conduct” including, but not limited to, obscene, profane or abusive language or gestures, comments of a personal nature intended to degrade an Official or persist in disputing a ruling after being told to stop or after being penalized for such behavior.

According to the referee's report, Kubat Karel criticized the referee's activity at the 20th minutes of the game, in an unsportsmanlike tone. The incident is not visible in the game recording.

The Disciplinary Committee, considering all the circumstances of the case, does not apply any additional sanction to the player.
